Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are necessary for the website to function. They are only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as logging in or filling in forms.

Analytics Cookies

These cookies allow us to count page views and traffic sources so we can better understand how visitors discover and make use of our website. All information derived by use of these cookies is aggregated and therefore anonymous.

Performance Cookies

Performance cookies are used to analyse and understand the key performance indexes of the website, such as page load times. This helps us understand how the website is performing and where we can optimise to provide a better user experience for our visitors. All information derived by use of these cookies is aggregated and therefore anonymous.

Functionality Cookies

These cookies enable the website to provide enhanced functionality and personalisation such as displaying the nearest regional phone number or content in your preferred language. They may be set by us or by third party providers whose services we have added to our pages. These cookies do not store any personally identifiable information, but are used to save preferences in your internet browser, such as your preferred country or language.
